This privacy policy has been drawn up pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, “regarding the protection of natural persons with respect to the processing of personal data, as well as the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation),” and updates previous versions released prior to this. We inform you that this privacy policy applies exclusively to online activities on the website www.studiolegalestefanelli.it and is valid for visitors/users of the site. It does not apply to information collected through channels other than this website. In compliance with the obligations deriving from national and EU legislation on the protection of personal data, this website respects and protects the privacy of its visitors and users. The collection and processing of your personal data will be carried out in accordance with the following:

2. TYPES OF PERSONAL DATA PROCESSED

The personal data collected and processed through this website are as follows:

- **Browsing data**
Like all websites, this site collects certain personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols. This category of data includes IP addresses or domain names of the computers used by users connecting to the site, URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) addresses of the resources requested, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the server's response (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the user's operating system and computer environment.
- **Data provided by the user**
These are data voluntarily entered by the user into the appropriate fields provided on this website.
- **Cookies**

3. PURPOSES OF DATA PROCESSING AND LEGAL BASIS

Your personal data has been provided by you and will be processed for the following purposes:

This data is acquired by the computer systems and software procedures of this website as part of its normal operation. It consists of information that is not collected to be associated with identified individuals, but which, by its very nature, could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, enable the identification of users. Such data is used solely to obtain anonymous statistical information on the use of the website and to monitor its proper functioning. Additionally, it may be used to establish liability in the event of potential cybercrimes against the website. This data is collected based on the user's consent, which is given by continuing to browse the site (implicit behaviour).

The data provided by the user will be used for the following purposes:

- Registration to access the services offered by this website;
- Subscription to webinars;
- Sending informational newsletters relating to legislative updates, case law, technical comments, or promotional initiatives by the members of the firm;
- Conducting market research and sending informational material about the activities of our law firm via email.

This data is collected based on a contract between the user and the data controllers for registration or webinar subscription requests or based on the explicit consent of the data subject.

4. NATURE OF DATA PROVISION AND CONSEQUENCES OF REFUSING TO PROVIDE DATA

5. TO WHOM WILL MY DATA BE COMMUNICATED?

Your personal data will be processed by the employees and collaborators of the Data Controllers.

Third parties who process data on behalf of the Data Controller, as Data Processors, may have access to your data, including providers of IT services (CRM), website maintenance providers or services for sending communications.

6. ARE MY DATA TRANSFERRED OUTSIDE THE EUROPEAN UNION?

Your data are transferred outside the European Union. The transfer of your data is lawful because the European Commission has determined that the third country to which they are transferred provides an adequate level of protection for your data.

7. HOW LONG WILL MY DATA BE STORED?

The Data Controller will keep your personal data for no longer than is necessary to achieve the purposes for which it is processed. Specifically, your data will be stored for the time necessary to provide the service requested by the user.

At the end of this period, the Controller will irreversibly delete the data - using destruction or secure deletion methods - or keep them in an anonymous form that does not allow you to be identified, even indirectly.

8. WILL I BE SUBJECT TO PROFILING?

In no case will your data be used to obtain information about your preferences or behaviour, nor will you be subject to any decision based solely on the automated processing of your personal data.

9. WHAT ARE MY RIGHTS?

You have the following rights:

- **Right of access to data:** the right to obtain confirmation from the Controller as to whether or not personal data concerning you are being processed and, if so, to gain access to your personal data – and a copy thereof – and to receive information related to the processing;
- **Right to rectification of data:** the right to obtain from the Controller, without undue delay, the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning you and the completion of incomplete personal data, including by providing a supplementary declaration.
- **Right to data erasure:** the right to obtain from the Controller, without undue delay, the erasure of personal data concerning you for any of the following reasons:
 - The personal data are no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed;
 - The data subject objects to the processing, and there is no overriding legitimate reason to continue the processing;
 - The personal data have been processed unlawfully;
 - The personal data must be erased to comply with a legal obligation to which the Controller is subject;
 - The personal data were collected in connection with the offering of information society services.
- **Right to restriction of processing:** the right to obtain from the Controller a restriction on processing under one of the following conditions:
 - You contest the accuracy of the personal data, for the period necessary for the Controller to verify the accuracy of the data;
 - The processing is unlawful, and you object to the erasure of the personal data and instead request the restriction of their use;
 - Although the Controller no longer needs them for processing purposes, the personal data are necessary for you to establish, exercise, or defend a legal claim;

- You have objected to the processing, pending verification of whether the Controller's legitimate grounds outweigh your own.
- **Right to data portability:** the right to receive, in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format, the personal data concerning you provided to the Controller and to transmit such data to another Controller if the processing is based on consent or a contract and is carried out by automated means.
- **Right to object to processing:** the right to object to processing carried out for the performance of a task in the public interest or in connection with the exercise of public powers or based on the Controller's or third parties' legitimate interests, as well as the right to object to the processing of personal data concerning you carried out for direct marketing purposes, including profiling insofar as it relates to such direct marketing.
- Right not to be subject to a **decision based solely on automated processing:** including profiling, which produces legal effects concerning you or similarly significantly affects you.

10. HOW CAN I FILE A COMPLAINT?

If you wish to file a complaint regarding how your personal data are processed by the Data Controller or regarding the handling of a complaint you have submitted, you have the right to lodge a complaint directly with the Italian Data Protection Authority following the procedures indicated on the website: www.garanteprivacy.it.
